Effectiveness of Outpatient versus Operating Room Hysteroscopy for the Diagnosis and Treatment of Uterine Conditions: A Systematic Review and Meta-Analysis

I am a second year Master's student, supervised by Dr. Kednapa Thavorn. My thesis work focuses on carrying out a Health Economic Evaluation comparing an outpatient uterine assessment and treatment unit to the current standard of providing gynecological care. I have worked as a Research Assistant at the OHRI for four years, collaborating on numerous different research projects. I obtained my BSc in Biology at the University of Ottawa.

Overview of Talk

Traditionally, hysteroscopy has been performed in the main operating room under general anaesthesia and often requires multiple pre and post operative health care visits. With advances in minimally invasive gynecology, hysteroscopy may be performed in an office setting, avoiding the risks of general anaesthesia. The aim of this talk is to present a systematic review and meta-analysis that synthesizes the relevant literature on the effectiveness of outpatient hysteroscopy compared to hysteroscopy performed in the operating room.
