

PRC FELLOWSHIPS 2018

CRABTREE FAMILY FELLOWSHIP

This fellowship has been established by the Harold Crabtree Foundation to fund a Postdoctoral Fellow who is conducting research on Parkinson's disease.

This Fellowship is **\$30,000** for one year (subject to available funds)

TOTH FAMILY FELLOWSHIP

This fellowship has been established by the John Toth Family to award a scholarship to a deserving Graduate Student at the Faculty of Medicine who is conducting research on Parkinson's disease.

This Fellowship is **\$15,000** for one year (subject to available funds)

AUDREY GRANT PARKINSON'S RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP

This fellowship has been established to fund a deserving Graduate Student in great appreciation for the efforts of Audrey Grant in her continued support of the PRC through her Annual Better Bridge Event.

This Fellowship is **\$15,000** for one year (subject to available funds)

BONNIE & DON POOLE PARKINSON'S RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP

This new fellowship has established by the Poole family to fund a deserving Graduate Student who is conducting research on Parkinson's disease.

This Fellowship is **\$15,000** for one year (subject to available funds)

SHELBY HAYTER FELLOWSHIP

This fellowship has been established by Shelby Hayter as a result of her Pass the Baton program to fund a deserving Graduate Student for two years at **\$15,000** per year (subject to available funds)

LARRY HAFFNER FELLOWSHIP

This fellowship has been established by Larry Haffner to fund a deserving Graduate Student for two years at **\$15,000** per year (subject to available funds)

Eligibility and Terms for all Fellowships:

Applicants must be graduate students or postdoctoral fellows who work for members of the Parkinson Research Consortium.

The tenure of the awards is:

- **Crabtree Fellowship:** Postdoctoral Fellow - One year at \$30,000
- **Toth Fellowship:** Graduate Student - One year at \$15,000
- **Audrey Grant Fellowship:** Graduate Student - One year at \$15,000
- **Bonnie & Don Poole Parkinson's Research Fellowship:** Graduate Student - One year at \$15,000
- **Shelby Hayter Fellowship:** Graduate Students - Two years at \$15,000 per year
- **Larry Haffner Fellowship:** Graduate Students - Two years at \$15,000 per year

These awards are non-renewable. A student cannot apply for the same Fellowship she/he has already been awarded. However he/she can apply for the others but are limited to only 2 years of funding.

The award will be given to a Student or Postdoc who is working on projects directly related to PD research.

Note: that fellowship funding support will be approved based on 1/3 institutional match. OHRI and Faculty of Medicine 1/3 match have already been confirmed.

Review Process:

The application deadline is **August 31st** and the following documents must be submitted electronically in PDF format to Natasha Hollywood at nhollwo@uottawa.ca

- a) Application form face sheet
- b) Complete CV – limit of 2 pages
- c) A ½ page personal statement of the research to be performed
- d) 1 page scientific proposal
- e) 2 letters of reference
- f) Institutional letter of support committing to 1/3 match (not required for OHRI and Faculty of Medicine Applicants)

All applications will be reviewed by a scientific review committee and the PRC Advisory Board.
