Pharmacy Fee Schedule for Clinical Trial Services

Study start-up

Includes:

- Review of the protocol
- Review Feasibility of Formulating Product/Placebo (blinding procedures, placebo manufacturing and stability)
- Preparation of a Pharmacy cost estimate
- · Providing and completing documents necessary for study initiation
- Investigation into drug related questions (i.e. Requiring Drug Information Pharmacist, inventory & ordering etc.)
- Preparation of Pharmacy procedure and dispensing documents
- Review of randomization tables
- Preparation of necessary logs, manufacturing sheets, auxiliary labels and all other documents
- Attendance of Study Initiation meetings
- Staff training and education required for study initiation and maintenance
- Catalogue item creation and validation in EPIC system (required for dispensing)
- Procurement/receipt of initial supplies

Study maintenance fee

Monthly fees will be charged bi-annually in April & October. Charges will begin accumulating upon study commencement.

Includes:

- Inventory control & maintenance of accountability records
- Receipt of investigational product (IVRS/IWRS and Temp Tale reading & reporting)
- Drug destruction and preparation of required documentation
- Storage of IP
- Equipment maintenance and calibration for storage
- Daily temperature monitoring (room temperature/refrigerator/freezer)
- Meetings with Investigators, Sponsors, Monitors or Suppliers
- Billing administration (bi-annually in April & October)
- CRA visits (visits in excess of 4 per year may be subject to additional service fees)

Dispensing fees

Includes:

- Investigational drug preparation, labelling and dispensing
- · Initial order review by Pharmacist
- Product verification by Pharmacy Technicians
- IP return accountability, recording in study documents and storage until CRA accountability is performed

On-call Fees

Includes:

- Pharmacy Technician available on-call Monday to Friday from 4pm-9:30pm (General Campus) 3:30pm-9:00pm (Civic Campus) and Saturday/Sundays/Statutory holidays from 7:30am-9:00pm (all campuses)
- Monthly fee is shared evenly amongst all studies utilizing the on-call services during that month

Call Back Fee

Includes:

 Pharmacy Technician returns to the Pharmacy department for preparation and dispensing of a Clinical Trial investigational product within the on-call hours

Additional Services Not Listed

Includes:

- Overtime (charged in 30-minute increments)
- Manufacturing & packaging
- Re-labelling
- Any other services not listed

Amendments Requiring a Change to Pharmacy Operations and/or Medication

Amendment fee will only be charged if changes affect Pharmacy operations and/or include changes to the medication that would require a change in the EPIC system catalogue item.

Study Close-out

Includes:

- Return/destruction of investigational supplies
- Close-out visit and completion of study documents
- Prepare and maintain documents to transfer pharmacy material(s) to PI for extended storage

Storage Fee (for trials with no Pharmacy involvement)

Investigational product storage and temperature monitoring for Clinical Trials operating without Pharmacy services.
